

## German Stoneware (421)

## 1550-1750

Very hard, even, grey fabric. Quartz inclusions can be seen under magnification. Pale grey/brown on the outside. Salt (mottled) glazed.

1550f: Post medieval had flat bases and a speckled glaze. Not rare. Drinking vessels. Millions imported.

e.g. Frechen Ware (from Frechen/Cologne area) mainly Bartmann jugs (face jugs). Also Bellarmine jugs (applied face of Cardinal Roberto Bellarmino (1542-1621)).
