

Midland Purple

1450-1600

Very hard purple, dark red, brown or grey fabric. Wheel thrown. Slightly pimply surface. Can have a purple or black glaze which does not cover the whole pot. Wide variety of pots made, e.g. jars, bowls and jugs.
