

## Early/Middle Saxon

## 5<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> century

Hand built wares. Range of colours, dependent on firing, e.g. black, red, grey, brown. (Ours are mainly blackish.) Organic temper e.g. grass and seeds. People made this for their own use as this pottery does not travel well. Simple jars and bowls, but some stamps and scored line patterns, particularly on cremation urns. Sparkly appearance, sandy feel.
