

Roman Grey Wares (LNVGW)

C1-3

Very variable fabrics. Grey (all shades), without obvious inclusions. Cookware through to tableware. Jars, dishes, bowls, plates, lids, cups, cauldrons and frying pans. Used to boil water. Can be smooth or sandy, thin walled or thick. Sometimes sandwich effect from incomplete firing. Roulette decoration (shaped stamper rolled around the wet clay pot).
